The **natural aural approach** seeks to manage deafness in children whilst allowing them to enjoy, and benefit from, the normal childhood experiences within their home, community and culture that enable all children to learn and develop.

With the technology available today, fitted and managed well, and worn during all waking hours deaf children have a real chance to hear. They will then have the opportunity to learn and develop through listening in the same way as normally hearing children do.



The **natural aural approach** empowers parents to recognise their natural skills to support the development of language through listening and talking.

Given these early opportunities to develop and learn through listening and talking – **deaf children have real choices in their future.**
